Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-34165-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Stockton East Water District as represented by Justin Hopkins.

The project involves the removal and replacement of an existing flashboard dam over Calaveras River. The new dam will be installed in approximately the same footprint as the existing dam.


