

# **Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration**

## **Environmental Assessment/Initial Study for Delta-Mendota Canal Subsidence Correction Project**

The San Luis & Delta-Mendota Water Authority has released for a 30-day public review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) an Environmental Assessment (EA)/Initial Study (IS) and draft Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) on the effects of the proposed subsidence correction project to restore the Delta-Mendota Canal (DMC) to its originally authorized conveyance capacity. The proposed project analyzed in this EA/IS would raise currently deficient canal lining, embankment, and other impacted structures to allow the DMC to convey its originally authorized capacity while satisfying current Bureau of Reclamation safety standards. Proposed project effects would occur within Alameda, San Joaquin, Stanislaus, Merced, Fresno, San Benito, and Santa Clara counties.
