Location: Sovereign land in Lake Tahoe, adjacent to 4020 North Lake Boulevard, Carnelian Bay Placer County.

Description: Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational Use beginning March 1, 2023, for a term of 10 years, for the use and maintenance of existing pier, two catwalks, a portion of a boathouse with sundeck, railing and stairs, boat lift, and two mooring buoys.
