**PROJECT TITLE:** Emergency Boiler Shop Truss Shoring

**LOCATION:** Old Sacramento State Historic Park **COUNTY:** Sacramento County

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** California State Parks proposes to install scaffold shoring to brace the roof structure of the historic Boiler Shop building in the Railyards portion of Old Sacramento State Historic Park. The roof sustained significant wind damage during the January 2023 storm system. The shoring is to ensure the health and safety of staff who are based in the Boiler Shop as well as the preservation of the historic building. Scaffold shoring towers will be in place until Boiler Shop “clean and safe” project is underway and can repair truss assembly (approximately 1 to 2 years).

Work will: install scaffold shoring to brace the underside of the roof purlin(s) framing on each side of damaged roof truss

This project follows the Secretary of Interior’s Standards of Rehabilitation.
