This project is an Administrative Use Permit for a heavy equipment rental and storage yard constructed in 2 phases over 5 years. Phase One to include a 1,440-square-foot office building and a 17.66-acre area for outdoor storage of equipment. Phase Two, with permits issued within 5 years, to include a 20,000-square-foot shop which will be used for the maintenance of equipment and additional parking. There is an existing approved operable vehicle storage facility that will continue to operate on site. The project site will utilize well for water, septic for sewer, and natural drainage for storm water. This project site is not under a Williamson Act Contract. (Use Type: Equipment Sales, Repair, and Storage-Heavy Equipment, Sales).
