## **Draft Supplemental Environmental Assessment (SEA) and Unsigned Mitigated Finding of No Significant Impact (Mitigated FONSI) for Ongoing and Future Military Training, Support Operations, and Resource Management at the Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center**

In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act, the U.S. Marine Corps' Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command (MAGTFTC) has prepared a Draft SEA and unsigned Mitigated FONSI for ongoing actions, changes to ongoing actions, and new proposed actions at the Combat Center. The main categories of actions occurring at the Combat Center are classified as: military training, support operations, and resource management. The resources and issues analyzed in detail (individually and cumulatively) include – *Air Quality, Biological Resources (Desert Tortoise), Climate Change, Cultural Resources, Environmental Justice (Noise), and Human Health and Safety (Herbicides)*. Climate Change and Environmental Justice are included due to the recent re-emphasis at the federal level.

MAGTFTC will accept public comments on the Draft SEA and unsigned Mitigated FONSI from **1 May to 31 May 2023**.
