I was recently requested to review the Notice of Environmental Impact document from the State Clearinghouse (SCH) related to the proposed Nash Road Quarry Reclamation Plan (Mine ID# 91-35-0015) located at 1070 Nash Road, Hollister Ca 95023. The California Highway Patrol's (CHP) interest in commenting surrounds our concerns for the increase in heavy commercial vehicle traffic along the proposed routes. The plan needs to ensure all roadways being utilized when moving from the mine to the concrete batch plant and supply yard, can support the weight of the loaded trucks and will not degrade. The plan also needs to ensure any roadway being used by the trucks have adequate traffic control devices for all types of motor vehicles and allow for the safe transportation of all vehicles on the roadway. We are hopeful plant operators will establish, monitor, and enforce plant rules related to vehicle/commercial vehicle safety as CHP personnel work to assure compliance with California Vehicle Code provisions.
