Project Title: Clear Lake Oaks/Keys Aquatic Weed Harvest (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. LAK-15743-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Clear Lake, in the County of Lake, State of California; Latitude 39.01925, Longitude -122.66584.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number LAK-15743-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Clear Lake Keys Property Owners Association as represented by Edward Legan.

The project is limited to the annual cutting, removal, pulling or mechanical harvesting of invasive aquatic weeds in the Clear Lake Oaks/Keys community. The plant material that is removed by hand will be dried on the adjacent landowner's property and placed in the green waste once it is desiccated. Materials removed by the floating mechanical harvester will be taken offsite in bulk to be dried and appropriately disposed of so that it does not re-enter Clear Lake.
