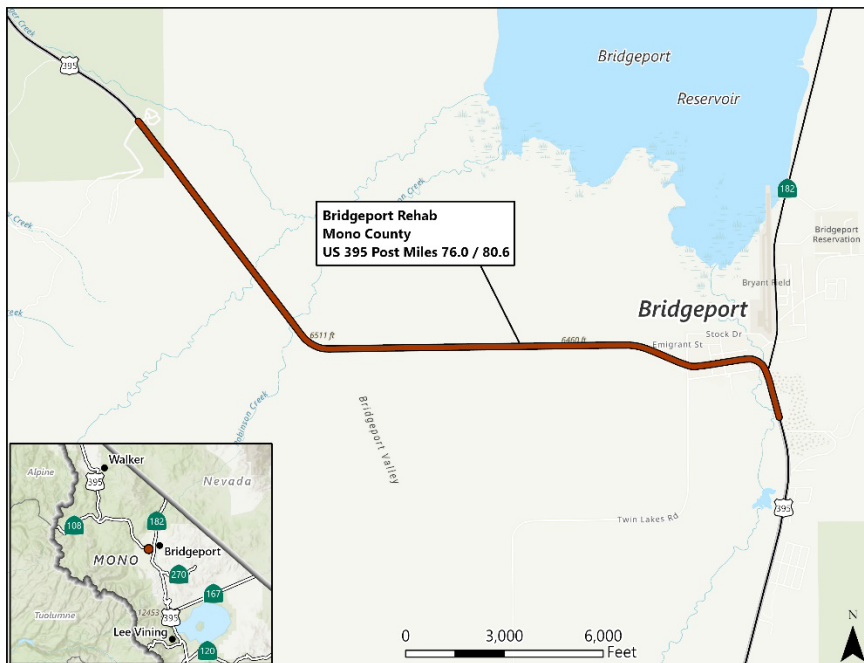


## Notice of Availability of Draft Environmental Impact Report and Opportunity for Public Hearing

**What's Being Planned?** The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to rehabilitate pavement, replace nonstandard highway facilities, and make other improvements on U.S. Route 395 from post miles 76.00 to 80.60 in the community of Bridgeport in Mono County.

**Why This Public Notice?** Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the project will result in significant impacts related to biological resources. The report that explains why is called an Environmental Impact Report. This notice is to inform you of the completion of the draft Environmental Impact Report and of its availability for you to read and comment on. The opportunity exists for a public hearing should multiple members of the public request one.

**Public Comment Period.** Comments will be accepted from November 4th, 2024, to December 19th, 2024. If there are no major comments or requests for a public hearing, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.
