The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has reviewed the draft Initial Study and Negative Declaration (ISND), dated March 2023, for the above referenced project which proposes a general update of Title 17, Zoning, of the Dunsmuir Municipal Code (Project). CDFW's review of this Project is pursuant to our role as the State's trustee agency for fish and wildlife resources under the California Environmental Quality Act, California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq. Additionally, as a State responsible agency, CDFW administers the California Endangered Species Act and other provisions of the Fish and Game Code that conserves the State's fish and wildlife public trust resources.

As described in the ISND, the municipal code update will not, in and of itself, result in impacts to biological resources therefore, the CDFW has no comment. CDFW appreciates the opportunity to comment on the Project to assist the City of Dunsmuir in adequately analyzing and minimizing impacts to biological resources.
