## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR SHALANE TANK AND TRANSMISSION PIPELINE PROJECT

This notice is to inform the public and interested agencies that in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), East Niles Community Services District is circulating Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for public comment.

Project/Location: Tank site is located on an undeveloped Land just west of Shalane avenue. The transmission pipeline alignment would be underneath Shalane ave going west and terminate at Ca. State 184 (Kern County Rd.)

Project Description: The project will consist of constructing an above-ground welded steel nominal 2.0 MG reservoir with approximate dimensions of 24 feet high and 120 feet in diameter. The work will include providing onsite inlet and outlet piping and appurtenances as well as constructing the 5,400-foot long 16" diameter transmission main between the tank site and the 650 zone transmission piping in Morning Drive at Kern Canyon Road. It is anticipated that the pipeline route will run west along Shalane to Kern Canyon and then west along Kern Canyon to Morning Dr. (See below photo)
