Title: San Francisco Bay Fiber Optic Cables Project

Applicant: Bandwidth Infrastructure Group, LLC

Location: Sovereign tide and submerged land in the San Francisco Bay, between Brisbane in San Mateo County and San Leandro in Alameda County

Description: Installation, use, and maintenance of two 2-inch-diameter subsea fiber optic cables buried 3 to 6 feet and two 8-inch-diameter high-density polyethylene conduits installed 6.5 to 66 feet under the San Francisco Bay. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 25-year General Lease – Right-of-Way Use through April 30, 2048.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on June 5, 2023, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
