The Project Area is bounded by Placer Avenue to the east, the El Dorado/Placer County line at Pine Avenue with a drain extending into a California Tahoe Conservancy owned parcel in Placer County between Miami and Hilo avenues to the north, McKinney Road and Bellevue Avenue to the west, and undeveloped USFS and Conservancy-owned lots to the south. The objective of the Project is to design and implement erosion control and water quality improvement measures that will reduce the discharge of sediment and pollutants to Lake Tahoe from County administered rights-of-way. The County is proposing to improve the water quality of runoff to Lake Tahoe and its tributaries by reducing erosion and sediment transport originating from the Project Area.
