Project Location: The Project is located at 441 and 446 Creekside Road, Hyampom, in Trinity County.

Project Description:

The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Procession Code Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved two (2) Cannabis Cultivation Licenses submitted by Nina Kalani.

Project Activities:

The Project will consist of cannabis cultivation on adjoining parcels at 441 Creekside Road (APN:011-400-05) and 446 Creekside road (APN: 011-220-16-00) near Hyampom, Trinity County. The Mixed-Light Tier 1 cultivation operations will occur on previously developed land and will consist of 9,600 square feet (441 Creekside Rd) and 4,200 square feet (446 Creekside Rd) of mature cannabis canopy grown in hoophouses.
