Project Title: Cannabis remediation and site cleanup at APN 572-130-007 (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-RIV-36178-R6)

Project Location (Riverside County): The project is located at 53494 Old Ranch Rd. in the City of Anza within Riverside County in the State of California; Latitude 33.568115 N, Longitude -116.729751 W; Assessor’s Parcel Number (APN) 572-130-007.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-RIV-36178-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Chue Yang.

The Project is limited to removing a sewage pit in the stream, restoring the impacted areas of stream to their natural state revegetating areas impacted by illicit cannabis cultivation, and removing and properly disposing of trash and debris associated with the illicit cannabis cultivation that took place on the Property.
