Thank you for including the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the review for the Mitigated Negative Determination (MND) of Chet Harritt Pump Station and Lake Jennings Aeration System and Clearwell Effluent Flow Meter Project (SCH #2023050202) located near Interstate 8 (I-8) in the Lakeside area. The mission of Caltrans is to provide a safe and reliable transportation network that serves all people and respects the environment. The Local Development Review (LDR) Program reviews land use projects and plans to ensure consistency with Caltrans' mission and state planning priorities. Caltrans has the following comments:

### Hauling

Caltrans has discretionary authority with respect to highways under its jurisdiction and may, upon application and if good cause appears, issue a special permit to operate or move a vehicle or combination of vehicles or special mobile equipment of a size or weight of vehicle or load exceeding the maximum limitations specified in the California Vehicle Code. The Caltrans Transportation Permits Issuance Branch is responsible for the issuance of these special transportation permits for oversize/overweight vehicles on the State Highway network.
