**Project Title:** Enterprise Solar Storage Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-KER-50847-R4)

**Project Location:** The Enterprise Solar Storage Project (Project) is located approximately 25 miles southeast of Tehachapi near Mojave and is composed of four sites: Site 1 (northern) is directly south of State Route (SR) 58, generally west of 10<sup>th</sup> Street and north of Purdy Avenue; Site 2 (western) is directly west of SR-14, east of 25<sup>th</sup> Street West, south of Camelot Boulevard, and generally north of Purdy Avenue; Site 3 (eastern) is east of 10<sup>th</sup> Street, south of SR-58, and north of Silver Queen Road; and Site 4 (southern) is south of the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway.


**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-KER-50847-R4, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicants, Enterprise Solar Storage, LLC; EdSan 2B Solar Storage, LLC; Enterprise Solar Storage A, LLC; Enterprise Solar Storage B, LLC; Enterprise Solar Storage C, LLC; Enterprise Solar Storage VI, LLC; Enterprise Solar Storage VII, LLC; Enterprise Solar Storage VIII, LLC; Enterprise Solar Storage IX, LLC; and Enterprise Solar Storage X, LLC.

The Project includes the construction of four non-contiguous utility-scale photovoltaic (PV) solar energy generating facilities, underground Medium Voltage (MV) lines, PV solar equipment, perimeter fencing, and access roads.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on 1/6/2025 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
