**Exempt Status:**

Categorical Exemption (PRC Section 21084; CEQA Guidelines Sections 15300 -15333):

- CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 – Existing Facilities

**Reasons why project is exempt:**

The project consists of the continued operation of an existing smoke shop and results in negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing and is therefore exempt from the provisions of CEQA.

**Section 15300.2 – Exceptions**

Section 15300.2 of the CEQA Guidelines, Exceptions, provides conditions under which categorical exemptions are inapplicable. Review of the Project indicates that it will not violate any of the exceptions, as described in the following section.

1. *The project will occur in certain specified sensitive environments or locations;*

The Project will have no impact on specified sensitive environments or locations.

2. *Cumulative impacts will be considerable because successive projects of the same type will occur at the same place overtime;*

The project will not result in significant singular or cumulative environmental impacts. No cumulative impact will result from the Project and successive projects of the same type and at the same place over time.
