Project Title: Non-industrial Timber Management Plan "Mohrhardt Ranch" 1-21NTMP-00006 SON (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SON-30901-R3)

Project Location (include county): The project is located northwest of the town of Cazadero at unnamed tributaries to Blue Jay Creek and Big Oat Creek in the County of Sonoma, State of California; portions of Section 1, 12, and 13, Township 8N, Range 12W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Fort Ross and Cazadero; Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SON-30901-R3 pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Mitchell Haydon, Environmental Resource Solutions, INC.

This project proposes to remove and replace culverts at nineteen Class III crossings, remove and replace culverts at two Class II crossings, remove and abandon the culvert at one Class II crossing, stabilize one bank seepage, and clean the culvert and inside ditches at one spring and one bank seep.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on May 3, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
