Project Title: Tesla Road Mile Marker 9.50 Emergency Storm Damage Repair, in Livermore, Alameda County.

Project Location - Specific: N/A, Alameda County.

Project Location - City: Livermore **Project Location - County:** Alameda

Description of, Nature, and Purpose of Project: : During the 2022-2023 winter storms, an approximately 80-foot-long section of the northbound Tesla Road at approximately MM 9.50 experienced subsidence failure due to heavy rainfall. Per site observations, the mode of failure might have included a potential clogged culvert which contributed to rainwater flow saturating the soil underneath the road, eroding the soil layers, and causing it to become unstable. Overtime, this potentially lead to the formation of voids resulting in sinks and settling into gaps which compromised the road surface in the form of cracks and deformations. The sinkage has caused the road to become impassable, resulting in traffic disruptions and safety hazards for pedestrians and vehicular traffic. Tesla Road is mainly used by vehicular traffic as an alternate Interstate 580 access to the Altamont Pass from the city of Tracy to the city of Livermore. The damaged section includes the northbound lane, a portion of the southbound lane, and the earthen embankment. The slope below the embankment is about 2.5:1 Both side of the roadways is currently closed on both directions. The temporary emergency repairs at Tesla Rd MM 9.50 consist of the removal of the debris along the damaged roadway, rebuilding the roadway by recompacting and grading the roadway with virgin Class 2 AB fill material and reconnect the storm drain with a new culvert pipe to match the existing pipe size. This will be followed by the reconstruction of the roadway with aggregate base grading and asphalt concrete paving.
