Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

Specific Plan, inclusive of two accompanying subdivision maps, three plot plans and a General Plan Amendment and Change of Zone on 619.1±-acres currently in agriculture. Comprised of a 223.1±-acre equestrian center, a mix of residential neighborhoods, workforce housing, estate lots, single-family attached and detached homes, and condominiums, providing up to 1,362 dwelling units ranging in densities from 0.60 to 27.3 units per acre. Would include 275,000± gross leasable square feet of retail and other commercial space, including 75,000± square feet of equestrian event-related retail space, and 10,000 square feet of office space; and up to 150,000 square feet of retail space, and a 150 room hotel.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The Draft EIR addresses:  
Aesthetics: The project will include structures up to 65 feet with most buildings and structures 40 feet or lower.  
Agricultural Resources: site includes prime and other farmlands: LESA analysis being prepared.  
Air Quality/GHG: construction-related and operational emissions, including moving emissions, to be analysed.  
Biological Resources: full site in long-term cultivation. No identified sensitive species on site. Surveys being conducted.  
Cultural/Tribal Resources: No identified sensitive historic, cultural or Tribal resources. Surveys being conducted.  
Geology/Soils: site subject to strong seismic groundshaking; high groundwater, collapsible soils.  
Hydrology/Flooding: no significant threats; project hydrology and effects to be analysed.  
Land Use Compatibility: area historically ag, but urbanizing nearby; Jacqueline Cochran Regional Airport to northeast.  
Noise: noise from airport operations is primary concern. Monitoring and modeling to be conducted.  
Paleontological Resources: surveys uncovered bi-valves typical of this area and associated with Lake Cahuilla lakebed.  
Population & Housing: area of Thermal and Mecca; safe and affordable housing and better paying jobs are issues.  
Public Services: area is generally well-served with police and fire protection, schools and health services.  
Recreation: No potentially significant impacts identified in NOP but will further analyse in forthcoming EIR.  
Transportation: could adversely affect existing capacity and require additional improvements to be analysed in EIR.
