**Project Title:** Madison Community Services District Water System Improvements (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. YOL-49930-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at the Madison Drain, tributary to the South Fork of the Willow Slough, in the County of Yolo, State of California; Latitude 38.681069° W, Longitude - 121.968213° N (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees), Sections 27, 28, 33, and 34, Township 10 N, Range 1 W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Madison quadrangle.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number YOL-49930-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Madison Community Services District (Madison CSD) as represented by Leo Refsland.

Madison CSD proposes to replace the network of underground water distribution system pipes and install a new section of pipe to provide an improved connection to the Madison Migrant Center. Approximately 12,000 feet of 8- and 12-inch diameter polyvinyl chloride pressure pipe would be placed in public roads within County right-of-way. The new pipe will cross the Madison Drain in two locations: 1) from the east end of Archer Street to CR-89, and 2) from the end of Rudolf Street to CR-89. Crossing the canal requires temporary work in the waterway. Where the pipeline crosses the Madison Drain, the pipe would be trenched a minimum of 36 inches below the bottom of the channel.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
