Project Title: Albany, Clement and Malano Sewer and Water Replacements

Project Applicant: City of Santa Rosa, Transportation and Public Works

Project Location – Specific: Albany St, Clement Ave, and Malano Ct

Project Description:

This project will upsize old 4-inch water mains in Albany St and Malano Ct and 6-inch water mains in Clement in conjunction with a sewer main project in the same area. Upsizing old, undersized mains increases fire flow and reduces maintenance costs. Approximately 1,775 LF of water main will be replaced. This project will also replace existing VCP sewer mains in Albany Dr from Oliver to Elliot, Clement Ave from Albany to Malano Ct and in Malano Ct. eliminating 3 sewer mains and storm crossings and a backyard sewer easement. Replacing VCP sewer mains reduces inflow and infiltration, and reduces maintenance costs. Approximately 1,135 LF of sewer main will be replaced. This project will remove failing 12-inch CMP storm drain that runs from the southwest corner to the northeast corner of the Albany Drive and Oliver Lane intersection. Approximately 70 LF of storm drain will be removed, and 300 SF of valley gutter will be installed to convey runoff across Albany Drive. The six existing pedestrian ramps within the limits of street construction shall be replaced to meet current ADA standards. Two new ADA ramps will be required at the intersection of Clement and Malano, where there is currently only curb and gutter. The streets will be reconstructed to full-width where a minimum of two utility replacements overlap.
