As lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act, the Port of Stockton is providing this Notice of Intent to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) assessing the potential environmental effects associated with the following project:

Port of Stockton BayoTech Hydrogen Production and Dispensing Facility Project

The proposed project location is at the intersection of W. Washington Street and Navy Drive in the East Complex of the Port of Stockton in Stockton, California.

The proposed project involves development and operation of a hydrogen production and dispensing facility at the Port of Stockton.
