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NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

PROJECT TITLE: Standard Road Rehabilitation Project (#1731)

PROJECT PROPONENT: Tuolumne County Department of Public Works

LOCATION: The project boundaries are on Standard Road, from Mono Way to Camage Ave, a distance of 1.43± miles. Portions of Section 34 Township 2 North, Range 15 East and of Section 3 and 10 Township 1 North, Range 15 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. Supervisorial District 2.

COUNTY: Tuolumne

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project consists of full depth reclamation (FDR) where the old asphalt and base materials will be pulverized and mixed with a stabilizing material, and recompact, to make new base for the new asphalt surface. The road will be 8 inches FDR with 4 inches of AC. The road reconstruction will be limited to the existing road width. The shoulder material will be graded to improve drainage. Sidewalk and crossings will be improved to allow for compliance with ADA. Following the road repairs, the road lanes will be striped with waterborne retroreflective paint. The project is to maintain an existing County road facility.

RATIONALE FOR EXEMPTION: After reviewing the project and its setting, the Environmental Coordinator for the County of Tuolumne has determined that the road repair on Standard Road is categorically exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to Section 15301 of the *State CEQA Guidelines*. The project includes the repair and maintenance of an existing roadway and involves negligible expansion of the existing use. None of the exceptions to the categorical exemptions provided in Section 15300.2 of the State CEQA Guidelines apply to the proposed project.
