PROJECT TITLE: Drainage Project Eastern Side of the Machine Shop

LOCATION: Railtown 1897 State Historic Park

COUNTY: Tuolumne

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The Drainage at the southeastern edge of the Railtown Roundhouse Machine shop is an old 6-inch ceramic pipe that has collapsed and is now plugged. This is not allowing any water that has accumulated at the footing of the eastern wall of the Machine shop to flow out. Repairs are needed to ensure that the machine shop drains properly Work will:

- Excavate an 3'W x 80'L x 3'D trench and add 3" of leveling sand to the bottom of the trench;
- In the corner of the machine shop, excavate and install a new catch basin (prefab concrete christy box or similar);
- Install a new 83-ft long, 6-inch drainpipe and tie into an existing cast iron drainpipe at the turntable wall;
- Cover the new pipe with ¾ -inch class 2 road base to 6-inches above the pipe and compact;
- Add additional backfill consisting of removed soils and compact to ground level; and
- Use either cold mix asphalt or hot mix, to patch.
