**Title:** Perform Carson Wandering Skipper Surveys in Honey Lake.

**Location:** State-Owned School and Sovereign land in Honey Lake, Lassen County.

**Description:** Request to enter State-Owned School and Sovereign lands in Honey Lake to perform surveys of the Carson Wandering Skipper, a federal endangered species that is known to occur at Honey Lake.

**Reasons for exemption:**

Issuance of a letter of non-objection to enter State-Owned School and Sovereign lands in Honey Lake to perform surveys of the Carson Wandering Skipper will cause only a minor physical change in the environment and will not change existing activities in the area. There are no unusual circumstances surrounding the project that will result in significant environmental impacts. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemption applies.
