## PUBLIC NOTICE INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION CITY OF SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA

Project Name: 550 Piercy Road Industrial Development Project

**Description:** The project application is for a Site Development Permit and Vesting Tentative Map to allow the construction of two industrial buildings on a 28.9-acre single vacant parcel located at 550 Piercy Road in San José, California. The total square footage of the proposed industrial buildings would be 430,000 square feet, with 257,149 square feet for Building 1 and 172,851 square feet for Building 2. Additional improvements for site circulation, site access, drainage, and infrastructure are included in the proposed project.

The City has performed an environmental review of the project.
