**Title:** Acceptance of a Lease Quitclaim Deed; and Issuance of a General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use – Lease 9152

**Location:** Sovereign land in the Sacramento River, adjacent to 2181 Garden Highway, near Sacramento, Sacramento County

**Description:** Authorize acceptance of a lease quitclaim deed, effective June 4, 2023, of Lease Number 9152, a General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use; authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use beginning June 5, 2023, for a term of 10 years, for the use and maintenance of an existing floating boat dock, two steel pilings, gangway, and bank protection.

**Reasons for exemption:**

Issuance of a 10-year General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use for the above-mentioned structures will not cause a physical change in the environment and will not change existing activities in the area. There is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemptions apply.
