NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

This notice is to inform the public and interested agencies that in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Town of San Anselmo is circulating Initial Study/Negative Declaration (ND) for public comment related to the Town of San Anselmo Housing Element 2023-2031 Update.

Project/Location: The project consists of an Initial Study/Negative Declaration to assess and analyze the proposed 2023-2031 Housing Element and any impacts related to the potential construction of 833 state mandated RHNA units in San Anselmo. The project description and analysis includes General Plan and Zoning Map amendments, as well as amendments to the Zoning Code to address and facilitate the State mandated new housing units.

Project Impacts: Based on the findings of the Initial Study, it has been determined that the project will not have a significant effect upon the environment.
