**Reasons why project is exempt:**



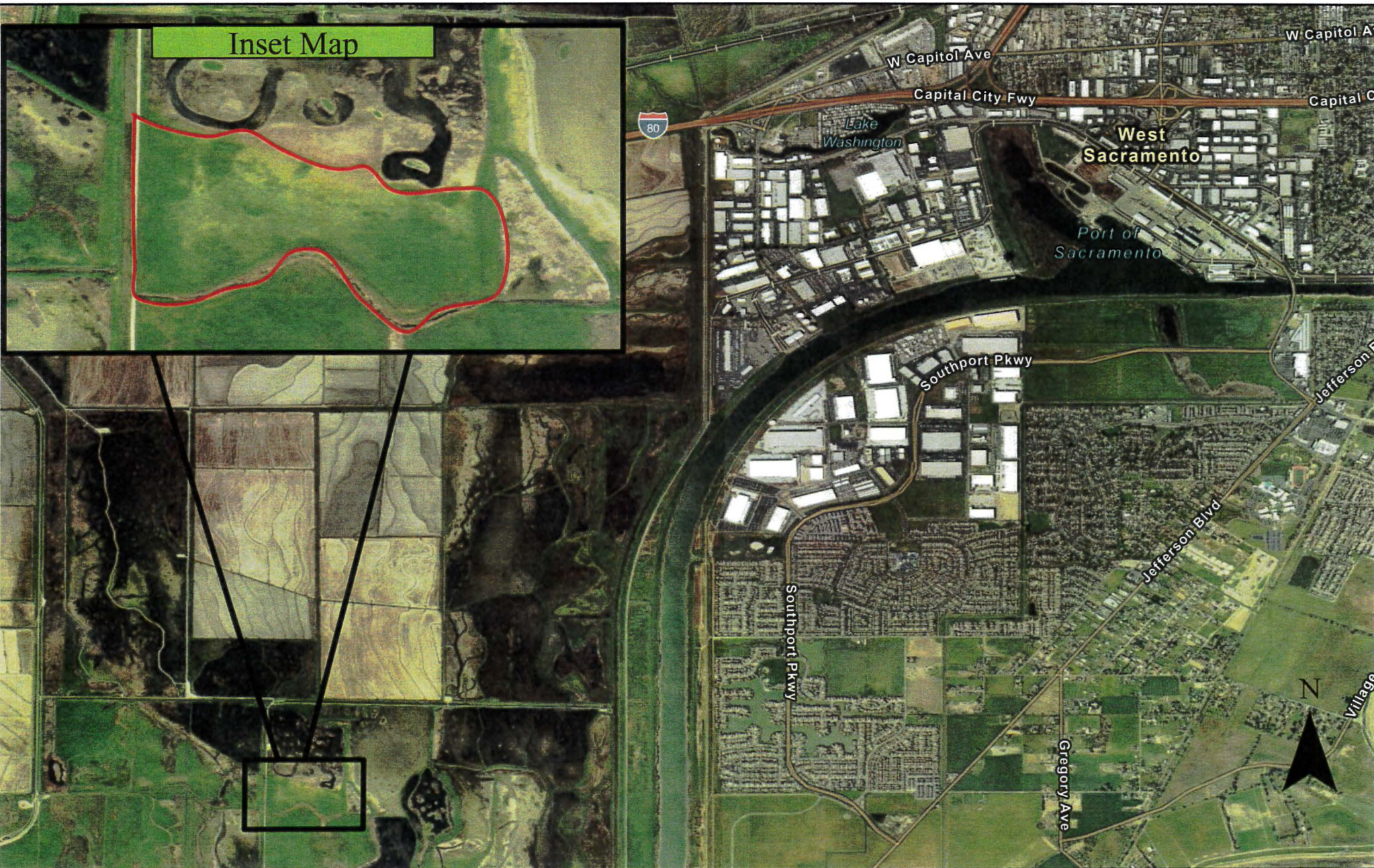

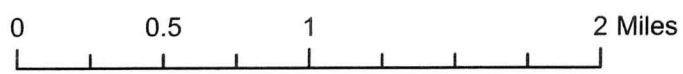

## Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area Pollinator Restoration Project

The Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area has identified and areas that lend itself to restoration to pollinator habitat. One field is centrally located on the wildlife area in the Mace Unit (MC8, Map A) and consists of 17.6 acres of upland habitat—less than one acre will be restored to native habitat.
