DWR is proposing to implement flood system and ecosystem improvements, and recreational opportunities to the lower Yolo Bypass/Cache Slough complex to increase flood capacity and provide floodplain habitat and ecosystem benefits. The Proposed Project would actively manage the transition of the land from agriculture to tidal wetlands, subtidal, and riparian habitat in a manner that maximizes flood benefits and climate resilience and enhances ecosystem processes and recreational opportunities. Sea-level rise and climate change are expected to significantly decrease the viability of maintaining the tract under existing conditions as a reclaimed landscape protected by aging limited-height levees. The Proposed Project would restore approximately 3,000 acres of habitat, while allowing increased flood conveyance at the southern end of the Yolo Bypass. See "Additional Information"
