(State CEQA Guidelines, § 15302.) Here, the Replacement Project falls within the Class 2 exemption as the proposed project entails the replacement of an existing utility system/facility and involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. For the foregoing reasons, the Replacement Project is categorically exempt from CEQA.
