Title: Gas Line 021G Replacement Project (L 021G/R-708) Across the Petaluma River

Applicant: Pacific Gas and Electric Company

Location: Sovereign land in the Petaluma River, adjacent to 3393 Petaluma Boulevard South, near Petaluma, Sonoma County.

Description: The Project would consist of the installation of a horizontal directionally drilled 16-inch-diameter natural gas pipeline; and the decommissioning and removal of two existing parallel 12-inch-diameter natural gas pipelines in the Petaluma River. The State Lands Commission action is to authorize an amendment to Lease Number PRC 5438-B, a General Lease – Right-of-Way Use, of sovereign land located in the Petaluma River, and authorize issuance of a General Lease – Right-of-Way Use to the Applicant beginning August 17, 2023, for a term of 20 years through August 16, 2043.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on August 17, 2023, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
