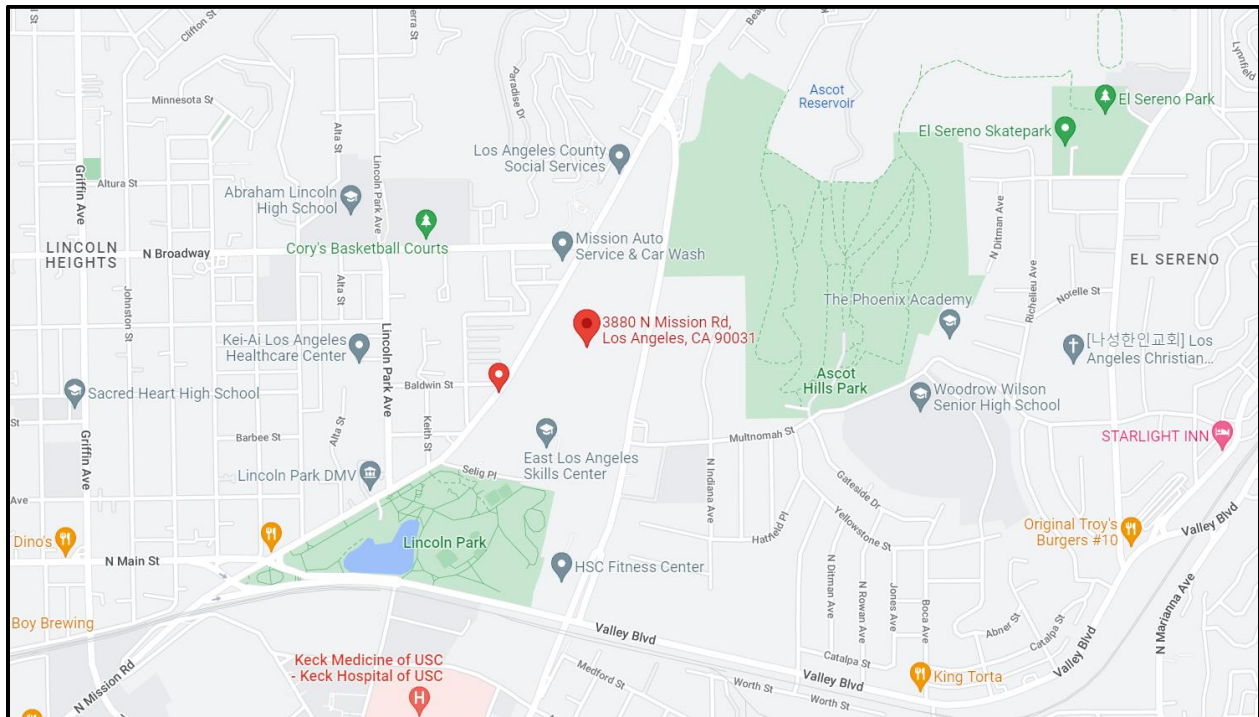

Dear Tribal Representative:

In conformance with the tribal consultation requirements of [Assembly Bill \(AB\) 52](#), this letter is to inform you that the Los Angeles Department of City Planning is reviewing the proposed project described below. Per AB 52, the tribe has the right to consult on a proposed public or private project prior to the release of a negative declaration, mitigated negative declaration or environmental impact report. The project description is as follows:

The project would involve the import of 285,493 cubic yards of soil to fill in a single-level subterranean parking level associated with an existing manufacturing building. The importation is expected to start in March 2024 and continue for 7 months until October 2024. Proposed hours of operation will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The project site is a level, irregular-shaped parcel of land encompassing approximately 1,683,9774 square feet (approximately 38.65 acres) of lot area. The following is a map showing the general location of the proposed project:
