Project Description:

The City of Davis Recycled Water Program (Proposed Project) is located approximately 1.5 miles northeast of the City of Davis in eastern Yolo County, north of I-80 and west of the Yolo Bypass, at the City of Davis Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP), located at 45400 County Road 28H. The Proposed Project would utilize approximately 1.8 million gallons per day of Saved Water generated by recent WWTP upgrades to create a Recycled Water Program that would supply recycled water to the following existing operations: The WWTP, the adjacent Overland Flow Area (OFA) (east of the WWTP), the Davis Restoration

Wetlands, and the Yolo County Central Landfill (YCCL). Recycled water would also be used throughout the City for City tree irrigation on City-owned properties and within City easements.
