PROJECT DESCRIPTION (please use a separate page if necessary)

The proposed project consists of a master planned storm drain improvement project. The project would construct an underground 6-foot by 4-foot reinforced concrete box (RCB) from an existing 6-foot by 3-foot RCB at Van Buren Boulevard, extending approximately 2,350 linear feet south and connecting to existing dual 48-inch RCP's at the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) railroad right-of-way. The project would also include the removal and replacement of portions of Avenue A, and the removal and replacement of an existing retaining wall. Approximately 2.02 acres would be disturbed by the proposed project including the construction staging area. The depth of the pipeline would be a minimum of 6 inches and a maximum depth of 9 feet below the existing surface. The limits of construction along the proposed storm drain alignment would be within an approximately 36-foot-wide area along the 2,350-foot alignment. The 36-foot area is within an existing 40-foot sanitary sewer and storm sewer easement.
