**Project Title:** Transfer of land coverage rights for construction of a gravel patio, fire pit and resolve coverage changes by previous owners.

**Project Location – Specific:**

The receiving parcel is located on 3670 Lacrosse Drive, Carnelian Bay, CA 96140 (Placer County Assessment Number 092-222-006), which is in the Carnelian Heights subdivision in Carnelian Bay.

**Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:**

The project consists of the transfer of 125 square feet of potential land coverage rights from Conservancy-owned land to the receiving parcel, identified above, on which a gravel patio and fire pit will be constructed next to an existing single-family residence. Additional coverage will be transferred to resolve coverage changes by previous owners. The transfer enables the receiving landowner to construct the additions without a net increase in the amount of existing land coverage in the Lake Tahoe Basin.
