The proposed project would involve the construction of 80 solar all-electric, three-story townhome-style condominiums, with the potential for up to 16 Americans with Disability Act (ADA) accessible accessory dwelling units (ADUs), distributed throughout 20 buildings. Access would be provided via two new inlet/outlet points via Gravenstein Highway North. The project would include a total of 160 parking spaces in garages and 58 surface spaces across the site. A new, enhanced 6-foot-wide pedestrian pathway is proposed to connect the West County Trail to Gravenstein Highway along the south border of the site.
