PROJECT TITLE: Calaveras Big Trees Maintenance Shop Mini Split System

LOCATION: Calaveras Big Trees State Park

COUNTY: Calaveras

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install a mini split air conditioning system at the maintenance shop at Calaveras Big Trees State Park to provided improved work conditions for the health and safety of park staff who work in the building. Work will:

- Install two (2) 11-in x 32-in. x 8-in. interior wall mount cassettes, one (1) each in the maintenance supervisor’s office space and in the employee office;
- Install a 27-in. x 27-in. interior ceiling cassette and face plate kit in the break room area;
- Install an interior 11-in. x 39-in. x 9-in. wall mount cassette in the shop area;
- Install a 39-in. x 38-in. x 14-in. multizone mini split on the northwest exterior wall; and
- Install all necessary electrical and communications wires, linesets, and a 220v disconnect.


