**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** California State Parks proposes to install electrical, water & waste hook-ups in the picnic area next to Jack Knight Hall at Calaveras Big Trees State Park to allow outside vendors the ability to bring in food trailers to provide food and/or drinks to park visitors. Work will:

- Install a lockable 50amp power receptacle on the exterior of bathroom #2 building and hookup to the power receptacle with 50 amp RV power cable;
- Install a water line through the water box that is located below the sink in old bathroom #2;
- Install a separator inside an existing abandoned restroom to ensure no grease or debris enters the sewer line.
- Collect grease, debris and old oil from the separator and store it temporarily in a bearproof shipping container located in the maintenance yard, and haul off-site for disposal; and
- Install sewer hookup through existing line in bathroom #2.
