**Project Title:** Noble Emergency Notice (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-SCR-38699-R3)

**Project Location (Santa Cruz):** The project is located at an unnamed Class II watercourse tributary to Shingle Mill Creek, a Class I watercourse, in the County of Santa Cruz, State of California; Section 21, Township 10 South, Range 2 West, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Felton, Mount Diablo base and meridian; GPS Coordinates 37.03967, -122.094043; Assessor’s Parcel Number 064-201-20.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SCR-38699-R3 pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Seth Noble.

The project is limited to removal of one bridge and the installation of one temporary Spittler crossing at map point X3 as denoted in the approved 1-23EM-00050-SCR Emergency Notice.

**Reasons why project is exempt:** The project will replace and remove existing temporary structures at the same site. There would be no significant adverse impact on endangered, threatened, or rare species or their habitat pursuant to §15065. There are no hazardous materials at or around the project site that may be disturbed or removed. The project will not result in impacts that are significant when viewed in connection with the effects of past projects, the effects of other current projects, and the effects of probable future projects. The Project will not have significant environmental impacts if completed under the protective measures outlined in Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SCR-38699-R3.
