Project Title: Timber Harvest Plan "Full Volume" 1-22-00097 SON (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SON-33487-R3)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at unnamed tributaries to the Wheatfield Fork Gualala River in the County of Sonoma, State of California; Sections 18, 19, 20, 27, 28, 30, 33, and 34, Township 10N, Range 13W; Sections 24 and 25, Township 10N, Range 14W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Annapolis 7.5' Quadrangle, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SON-33487-R3 pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Chris Hayter, Mendocino Redwood Company.

The project is limited to the removal and replacement of culverts at five Class III crossings and four Class II crossings, removal of six Class III temporary crossings, shotgun repair at a Class III crossing, installation of a rock-fill crossing at one Class III crossing, rock installation at two Class III crossings, and installation of road dips at two Class III crossings.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on June 19, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
