Project Location (include county): The project is located at an unnamed Class III watercourse tributary to Pescadero Creek which is a tributary to the Pajaro River in Santa Clara and Santa Cruz Counties, State of California; Portions of Rancho Salsipuedes, Township 11S, Range 3E; U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Annapolis 7.5' Quadrangle, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SCL-41143-R3 pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Tamia Marg, representing the Kelly-Thompson Ranch, LLC.

The project is limited to the replacement of one culvert at a Class III watercourse crossing with a rock ford as denoted in the approved 1-03NTMP-024 SCL-SCR "Kelly Thompson Ranch" Nonindustrial Timber Management Plan (NTMP, Exhibit A).

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on July 11, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
