Project Title: 2023 Winter Storm Emergency Repairs

Project Location:

The project occurs in the Town of Mammoth Lakes in Mono County, at two different locations:

- Tank T-8 (Forest Trail Tank)
- Wastewater Treatment Plant Equalization Basin Pump Building Roof

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

This project will occur at two locations in the Town of Mammoth Lakes, with the purpose of repairing and replacing existing infrastructure that was damaged during the historic winter of 2023.

<u>Tank T-8 (Forest Trail Tank)</u> – The existing 1,000,000 gallon bolted steel tank failed during the winter of 2023 under heavy snow loads. The existing tank will be demolished and replaced with a new 1,000,000 gallon welded steel potable water tank.

<u>Wastewater Treatment Plant Equalization Basin Pump Building Roof</u> – The existing flat truss roof system failed during the winter of 2023 under heavy snow loads. The existing roof will be demolished and replaced.
