Specific Project Location (identify street address and cross street or attach a map showing project site): The project site, George Gibbs Park, is comprised of 2.89 acres of land located at 1499 West 5th Street, located approximately 600 feet east of Benson Avenue within the City of Ontario.

Project Location: The project site is generally located in southwestern San Bernardino County, approximately 40 miles from downtown Los Angeles, 20 miles from downtown San Bernardino, and 30 miles from Orange County, within the City of Ontario. More specifically, the project site is located George Gibbs Park, 1499 West 5th Street and is situated on a single parcel of land.

Project Description: The project site is currently developed with a 2.89-acre public park that is comprised of a surface paved parking lot, a small softball field, and the remainder of the park is covered in turf grass for open play. The project will replace a large turf grass area and install new playground equipment that occupies approximately 4,688 square feet of land, a splash pad, outdoor fitness stations, a walking path with native gardens, a small play area for dogs, pickleball court, picnic tables, and a 466 square foot restroom facility.

Reasons Why Project Was Exempt: This project is located within the Open Space Recreation zoning district and surrounding land uses include single-family residential and a primary public school. The project site currently serves as a public park for the local community. The project involves the minor alteration of the existing park that includes the installation of a small restroom facilities and play structures/area that do not exceed 10,000 square feet in area. The Project does not alter the existing land use nor does it intensify the capacity. Approval of the project will not result in additional environmental impacts relating to aesthetics, erosion, stormwater, groundwater, traffic or air quality.
