PROJECT LOCATION: Laytonville in Mendocino County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the planning Project referred to internally as Laytonville Wastewater Project. The Project will develop alternatives to provide wastewater service to the Laytonville area in order to provide for commercial and residential growth, connect existing problems with on-site septic systems, protect public health and protect the local groundwater supply. The Project will evaluate the feasibility of constructing a public sewer system to serve the community.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on July 21, 2023 and determined that the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. The Laytonville Wastewater Project will be carrying out the Project.

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION STATUS:

Class 6: Information Collection

REASON WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: The Project has been determined to meet the requirements of the exemption selected above and will not have a significant impact on water quality. The Project consists of basic data collection and resource evaluation activities which do not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource.
