Project Title: Marin State Route 1 Capital Preventive Maintenance Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-MAN-28523-R3)

Project Location (Marin County): The Marin State Route 1 Capital Preventative Maintenance Project (Project) is located along State Route (SR) 1 in Marin County, California from Post Mile (PM) 22.8 to PM 50.5.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-MAN-28523-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Lindsay Vivian, California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) - District 4.

The Project is limited to the replacement of eight existing damaged or failed culverts. The Project will replace eight culverts along SR-1 in the following locations: Culvert Number 1 – (PM 24.16), Culvert Number 2 – (PM 30.51), Culvert Number 3 – (PM 30.66), Culvert Number 4 – (PM 32.82), Culvert Number 5 – (PM 49.21), Culvert Number 6 – (PM 49.5), Culvert Number 7 – (PM 49.7), and Culvert Number 8 – (PM 49.85).
