No work will be performed on bridge decks. There will be no increase in disturbed soil area (DSA) or impervious surface. Removal of thermoplastic pavement markings will be required along with a Lead Compliance Plan. This project will be constructed in 2024 and will take approximately 20 working days.

Purpose: The purpose of the project is to provide efficient, easily maintained pavement that provides minimum maintenance for multiple years, as well as increase safety for travelers and workers.

Need: The existing roadway and pavement surface has degraded to a point where maintenance is required to extend the pavements service life.

Right-of-Way

Acquisitions or TCEs will not be needed for this project due to work being confined to ROW.

Staging/Stockpiling

Multiple locations are available for staging/stockpiling use. No grading and/or site preparation will occur. Approved staging locations include:

PM 41.75 EB Gravel Pullout

PM 42.14 WB Gravel Pullout

PM 44.95 WB Large Gravel Pullout

PM 45.63 WB Large Gravel Pullout

PM 49.0 EB Large Paved Pullout

Disposal/Borrow Sites

The project would not utilize borrowed material. Excess material will be the property of the contractor.

Utilities

All utilities in proximity to the locations of work would be protected in place; no utility conflicts are anticipated.
