Project Location/Address/City/County: The project is located approximately 1.25 miles southeast of Linden, at river mile 13.2 of Mormon Slough in San Joaquin County.

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: To remove an existing low water crossing across Mormon Slough, permitted by Permit No. 5839. To construct a crossing composed of precast concrete box culverts as part of the Hosie Low-Water Road Crossing Fish Passage Project.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The Board has determined the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 2, Replacement or Reconstruction categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15302) because the activity consists of the removal of an existing low water crossing and replacement with a precast concrete box culvert with substantially the same purpose and capacity. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15300.2 apply.
